CHECK FOR RESPONSIVENESS	By shaking the victim and shouting	By shaking the victim and shouting	By patting victim's feet and chest
WHEN TO DIAL 911	Immediately if victim is unresponsive	After 1 to 2 minutes of performing CPR	After 1 to 2 minutes of performing CPR
PULSE LOCATION	Carotid artery (on the side of neck)	Carotid artery (on the side of neck)	Brachial artery (inner upper arm)
CIRCULATION	2 hands, 2" deep; 30 compressions	1 hand, 1" deep; 30 compressions	2 fingers 1/2 chest depth 30 compressions
AIRWAY	Lift the neck and tilt the head back	Lift the neck and tilt the head back	Slightly tilt the head into "sniffer's position"
BREATHING	Pinch the nose; give 2 breaths	Pinch the nose; give 2 breaths	Mouth over mouth & nose; give 2 puffs
Check for pulse every minute. Repeat C-A-B cycle as necessary until EMS arrives.			



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
